The fee for a regular permit with respect to all installations will be calculated as follows:

**Note:** \* Fee applies to permits having a classification of "Residential" with a construction type of T, C, MH, R, O and allows for one (1) inspection call.

\*\* Fee applies to permits having a classification of "Residential" with a construction type "New Installation", and allows for two (2) inspection calls.

**GENERAL**

- The Electrical Contractor is responsible to ensure that service entrance locations are approved by NSPI prior to installation.
- Where applicable a copy of the Building Permit must be forwarded to NSP before a utility power connection is made.
- The Contractor shall be responsible to ensure the job site is clearly identified to indicate Lot No., Civic No., or owner name; and to ensure the job site is accessible for inspections.
- Inspection will normally be carried out on the day the inspector is scheduled for the service area. Contractors shall schedule their work accordingly. Normally 5 days' notice will be required for scheduling of inspections.
- Plans and specifications shall be submitted as per Electrical Inspection Bulletin B-2-014 for all services over 250 ampere or 250 volts. The cost for plans examination shall be calculated on an as per review basis. Plans returned for rework due to incomplete or inaccurate information, or that are non-code compliant shall be subject to additional fees.

**I, the undersigned, certify that I am the holder of a valid Certificate of Qualification issued by the Province of Nova Scotia. I further certify that to the best of my ability the electrical installation will be in conformance with the applicable Provincial Acts and their Regulations, Utility Standards and related codes. Upon completion I understand that it is my responsibility to ensure that the installation is working in a safe and proper manner.**
